JOB DESCRIPTION

Job Summary

The Quality Community Outreach Worker will assist with engaging a target population to increase access to cancer screenings, referral to care and treatment after the screening is completed.

Job Duties

- Successful completion of motivational interviewing training.
- Completion of required quarterly training.
- Utilize motivational interviewing skills when speaking with patients.
- Conduct brief interventions between patients and providers that raise awareness of their health care concerns and motivate patients to make behavioral changes.
- Address social determinants of health and give resources as needed (including food, housing etc.)
- Address barriers to cancer screenings and other preventative healthcare needs.
- Collaborating with other departments within Packard Health and other community partners to assist with patient's needs.
- Regular follow-up with patients, community partners, and other healthcare workers.
- Ensure a positive patient and family experience.
- Ability to meet people where they are.
- Regularly report progress to Chief Quality Officer
- Self-motivated, proactive, independent
- Other duties as needed.
